



Michigan State Trooper Caleb Starr

End of Watch July 31, 2020

On August 25, 2020 at Lakeview Post, Cory Williams met Michigan State Post Commander Lt. Andy Fias, Lt. Christian Clute and Sgt. Painter to present the check for \$10,000 from Robert J. Turner Foundation. They presented the check to Rachael Starr (widow) of fallen Officer Caleb Starr.

On July 31, 2020, Trooper Caleb Starr succumbed to injuries sustained three weeks earlier when his vehicle was struck head-on by an intoxicated driver in Ionia County. He was traveling west on Grand River Avenue, in Boston Township, responding to a low-priority call when a vehicle crossed the center line and struck his vehicle. He had to be extricated from the vehicle and flown by helicopter to Spectrum Health Butterworth Hospital in Grand Rapids, where he remained until succumbing to his injuries. Trooper Starr served with the Michigan State Police for less than two years. He is survived by his wife and two children. (Officer Down Memorial Page).
